Life is hard for many, but not for Ben Carrie-Dewey, owner of Great Spatsby Manor and known for hosting lavish soirées. With exquisite food and extravagant surroundings, the evening was going smoothly until Carrie-Dewey is discovered dead in his study. Now all the dinner guests are suspects and solving the crime is up to the participants.

all over the Vail Valley and is our biggest fundraiser," said EagleARTS program director and treasurer, Jennifer Filipowski. "Each year we choose a different theme and this year we are excited to see everyone in their Gatsby attire — including sequined dresses, flapper hats, formal vests and fedoras — while they figure out whodunnit."

Guests can look forward to Broadway Street's transformation into a crime scene, hearing the suspects' alibis, asking them questions before guessing the killer's identity,

and looking for important clues. Ticketed participants who are ready to use their detective skills will check in at ARTSPaCE workshop+gallery at 139 Broadway between 5 and 6:15 p.m. before visiting suspects at Lilith Moon Exchange, Mountain Market & Supply, Mountain Table Top Gaming, Petals of Provence, Vail Valley Wellness and Vintage Green.

Once ticketed guests think they know who did it, how and why, they will make their way to the reveal party at ARTSPaCE and The Collective on Second

to turn in their guesses and enjoy food and drinks before learning the solution. All correct guesses will be entered to win one of many prizes. Themed costumes are encouraged.

Tickets are available for purchase at eaglearts.org/mob26 for \$75 (plus fees). Space is limited, so securing tickets prior to the event is highly recommended. Contestants who arrive by 6:15 p.m. will have time to complete the live game.
